




HIV AMONG PERSONS 60 YEARS AND OLDER IN MARYLAND, 2013



New HIV Diagnoses

- Individuals **60 years and older** accounted for **7.2% (100)** of the **1,395** reported adult/adolescent HIV diagnoses in Maryland in **2013**.
- The proportion of new adult/adolescent HIV diagnoses in Maryland per year among those 60 years and older has **increased** from **2.9%** in **1985**, now peaking to **7.2%** in **2013**.



Case rates among individuals 60+ years in newly reported diagnoses in 2013 were **8.8 cases per 100,000**.



Characteristics of Individuals 60+ Years Old

Living with HIV

- Of the **30,759** total living HIV cases (with or without AIDS) on 12/31/2013 in Maryland, **12.7% (3,896)** of those were **60 years and older**. In other words, **1 in 291** persons 60 years and older was reported to be living with HIV in Maryland.

Race/Ethnicity

- **74.4% NH Black**
- **19.0% NH White**
- **3.0% Hispanic**
- **3.6% NH other**



Gender

- **69.9% Male**
- **30.1% Female**

- **1 in 183 males** and **1 in 540 females** 60 years and older were reported to be living with HIV in Maryland.
- **31.8%** of individuals diagnosed at age 60 years and older with a reported exposure in Maryland were **heterosexual exposure**, **12.2%** were **men who have sex with men**, and **8.1%** were **injection drug users**.
- Of the **3,896** total living HIV cases in Maryland 60 years and older, **47.7% (1,859)** had a **viral load test** result reported in 2013. Of those **1,859** with a reported test result, **82.2%** had a **suppressed viral load**.
