


# Race/Ethnicity and HIV


Over three-quarters (76%) of living adult/adolescent cases of HIV are non-Hispanic Black. Fifteen percent are non-Hispanic White and 5% are Hispanic.

**Living Adult/Adolescent Maryland HIV Cases  
12/31/2012, N=28,978**



The rate of HIV is highest among non-Hispanic Blacks (1,569.8 per 100,000 population), almost ten times higher than the rate among non-Hispanic Whites (158.4). High rates are also experienced by non-Hispanics reporting multiple races (1,190.3) and non-Hispanic native Hawaiians and other Pacific Islanders (765.3).
