Where is PBCP?

PBCP refers to volunteer therapists throughout Maryland.

What does it cost?

FREE to those who are financially eligible.

Who is eligible?

Families, Couples & Individuals of all ages who:

- ◇ have limited incomes
- ◇ do not request care for chronic mental illness, alcohol or substance abuse
- ◇ do not require the therapist to appear in court
- ◇ do not present a threat of suicide or violence to the therapist
