




Maryland Home Visiting Timeline

Maryland Home Visiting Needs Assessment

- 46 at risk areas identified
- 13 federal priority indicators were measured with an additional 2 state specific measures (i.e., school readiness and WIC usage)
- Partnerships with key state agencies formed the executive stakeholder group.



MARCH

March 23, 2010 –Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Health Care Reform Act) became law.

APRIL/MAY

Governor’s Office for Children designates the Center for Maternal and Child Health as the applicant agency for the State of Maryland.

JUNE

June 10, 2010 –Federal Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) #1 for the Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program was released.

JULY

July 9, 2010 –Home Visiting Grant Application submitted on behalf of all partners interested in evidence-based home visiting .
July 27, 2010- Maryland was awarded the first \$500,000 of the allocation of the Home Visiting Program funds.

AUGUST

August 9, 2010- DHMH and GOC hosted Home Visiting Stakeholder’s meeting to present the preliminary data and gather input for the needs assessment.

SEPTEMBER

September 20, 2010 –Needs Assessment submitted
September 24, 2010- Needs Assessment approved by HRSA
