

# Oral Diseases and Injury Prevention Activity Reporting Form

## Data Definitions & Instructions

### Section 1: On-Site Children's Clinical Program

#### General Demographic

This measure includes a demographic breakdown of children screened in ***on-site children's clinical programs only*** by sex/gender, Hispanic identity, race, and insurance status.

#### Activities Performed

##### 1. Number of Patients Seen (Unduplicated Children)

The number of patients (children) seen refers to the total number of unduplicated children seen at the dental clinic only. This measure also includes a demographic breakdown of patients by age, gender, race, and insurance status.

##### 2. Number of Clinical Visits (Children)

The number of clinical visits (children) refers to the total number of dental visits provided to children in the dental clinic only. Please include multiple visits as separate counts, even if they are for the same patient.

##### 2a. Number of Children Receiving Emergency Treatment

Please do your best to collect this data. Include the number of emergency exam procedures and other instances of patients seen who require immediate treatment for pain, infection or trauma.

##### 3. Number of Children Receiving Sealants (in-clinic only)

Includes all children receiving sealants at the dental clinic only.

##### 4. Number of Children Receiving Fluoride Varnish

Includes all children receiving fluoride varnish at the dental clinic only.

##### 5. Number of Parents/Caregivers Educated on Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)

Includes all parents/caregivers at the dental clinic who were educated on HPV and head/neck cancer.

### Section 2 (A-B): Off-Site Oral Health Programs

#### General Demographic

This measure includes a demographic breakdown of pregnant and children screened in ***off-site children's oral health programs only including WIC programs*** sex/gender, Hispanic identity, race, and insurance status.

## Activities Performed (Section A-B)

### Number of Children Screened

Only in school-based settings, school-linked settings, and off-site settings, the data element "Number of Children /Screened" refers to the number of children/ pregnant women examined or screened by a dentist or dental hygienist. It should not include exams/screenings received at the dental clinic.

### Number of Children Receiving Fluoride Varnish

Only in school-based settings, school-linked settings, and off-site settings, the data element "Number of Children/ Pregnant Women Receiving Fluoride Varnish" refers to the number of children/pregnant women receiving a fluoride varnish in one of the above-mentioned settings. It should not include treatments received at the dental clinic.

### Number of Children Receiving Oral Health Education

Only in school-based settings, school-linked settings, and off-site settings, the data element "Number of Children/Pregnant Women Receiving Oral Health Education" refers to the number of children/pregnant women receiving oral health education in one of the above-mentioned settings. It should include not oral health education in any other setting.

### Number of Children/Pregnant Women Receiving a Dental Referral for Urgent Needs

Only in school-based settings, school-linked settings, and off-site settings, the data element "Number of Children/Pregnant Women Receiving a Dental Referral for Urgent Needs " refers to the number of children/pregnant women with urgent dental needs defined as a gross carious lesion(s) with or without signs or symptoms that may include pain, infection and/or swelling. The recommendation for their next dental visit is tantamount to an emergency referral or to be seen as soon as possible. For pregnant women, evidence of significant periodontal involvement may also be classified as an urgent need.

## **Section 3: On-Site Adult Clinical Program (Including Oral Cancer)**

### General Demographic

This measure includes a demographic breakdown of children screened in ***on-site adult clinical programs only by*** sex/gender, Hispanic identity, race, and insurance status.

### Activities Performed

#### 1. Number of Patients Seen (Adults)

The number of patients (adults) seen refers to the total number of unduplicated adults seen at the dental clinic only. This measure also includes a demographic breakdown of patients by age, gender, race, and insurance status.

#### 2. Number of Clinical Visits (Adults)

The number of clinical visits (adults) refers to the total number of dental visits provided to adults at the dental clinic only. Please include multiple visits as separate counts even if they are for the same patient.

2a. Number of Adults Receiving Emergency Treatment

Please do your best to collect this data. Include number of emergency exam procedures and other instances of patients seen who require immediate treatment for pain, infection or trauma.

**Section 4: Off-Site Oral Cancer Program**

1. Number of Oral Cancer Screenings

Includes the number of screenings performed.

2. Number of Oral Cancer Referrals for Biopsy

Included the number of oral cancer referrals for biopsy.

3. Number of Healthcare Providers Educated on Oral Cancer

Includes the number of healthcare providers (dental and/or medical) educated on oral cancer.

**Section 5: Dental Public Health Infrastructure Capacity Measures**

Number of Public Health Dentists (FTE)

The number of public health dentists refers to the full-time equivalency of all public health dentists on staff. To calculate this, calculate the sum total of all weekly hours public health dentists (serving in a clinical capacity) employed by the site, and divide by 40. Include contractual employees, and any other type of employee relationship, but do not include volunteers.

Number of Public Health Hygienists (FTE)

The number of public health hygienists refers to the full-time equivalency of all public health hygienists on staff. To calculate this, calculate the sum total of all weekly hours public health hygienists (serving in a clinical capacity) employed by the site, and divide by 40. Include contractual employees, and any other type of employee relationship, but do not include volunteers.
